Second meeting organized in Fuerth, Germany

The second meeting of the E-Chance project was held in Fuerth between the 19th and 20th of May 2014 and was attended by all involved partners (Turkey, France and Germany).

The main objectives of this second meeting were to discuss *training modules for female entrepreneurs and the collection of information about European best practices* regarding female entrepreneurship programs. The aim of collecting this information is to create a database of organizations for female entrepreneurs, which includes further details about the organization itself and activities of



related institutions around the European countries. The plan is to create a database for each country (of the involved partners) and their local organizations.

Another point of the discussion was exploring the *needs of the target group*: What are the main problems that are faced by women, who want to start their own business?

These needs were measured by a questionnaire, which was created during the time after the Kick-off meeting in Istanbul and sent to every country to be replied by local women, wanting to start a business. The results of the questionnaires were presented by every country.

Discussions of the project's website and the piloting details of blended learning course were followed by an *info-meeting from Stefan Dremer, employee of Nexus II. e.V.* about counselling entrepreneurs and new business starters in Germany. At the end of the meeting every involved country was asked to collect some information about their assigned module of creating E-courses for the target group until the next meeting, which is going to take place in Paris, France from the 30th to the 31st of October 2014.
