Sustainable Action Training for Youth – SUSTRAINITY

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On the February 1st 2020, the “Sustainable Action Training for Youth” (SUSTRAINITY) co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union project started, and it will run until January 31st 2022.

Partners of the project are: E-Juniors Association (France), Matera Hub (Italy), Markeut Skills (Spain), Danmar Computers (Poland), InnoHub Valencia (Spain).

SUSTRAINITY aims at fostering the sustainable initiatives undertaken by youth, providing them with comprehensive tools which will help them in the implementation of sustainable projects.

The development of the SUSTRAINITY project will be divided into 3 main results, with specific activities and tasks:

- *Guidelines to sustainability* compiling the information, existing tools and best practices on sustainable businesses. It will include: theoretical concepts; tools and Examples of Sustainable businesses best practices
- *Diagnostic tool for sustainable business competences* which will assess sustainable business skills and knowledge thanks to a set of dedicated questions
- *Panorama of sustainable business practices* that will take the form of an interactive online tool where young entrepreneurs can consult sustainable solutions for the different area of their businesses.

The first project meeting is scheduled on April 27th 2020 in Paris.
