





Press Release 4 - ELISTAT: the fifth transnational meeting of the ELISTAT Project consortium (2020-1-TR01-KA227-ADU-097696)

On August 3 and 4, 2023, the Elistat project consortium met in Gondomar, Portugal, for the fifth transnational meeting, organized by the Union of Parishes of Gondomar, Valbom and Jovim, and attended by all the project partners: Ankara Provincial Directorate of Family Social Policies, Asociatia de Therapye Familiala si de Cuplu Timisoara, E-Seniors: Initiation Des Seniors Aux Ntic Association, Inspira Education Informatics Industry and Trade Ltd. st., Sinergia Società Cooperativa Social, and Karabuk University.

At this meeting, the partners discussed a number of key topics, including each partner's presentation on local workshops and multiplier events. From each partner's experience and feedback, we learned valuable lessons about how to ensure the sustainability of the project and its quality and applicability.

The M-learning platform was also reviewed at this meeting to clear up some details that will contribute to the quality of the online training available.

In addition, the project's YouTube channel was discussed in detail, emphasizing its importance as a dissemination tool.

Administrative and management issues were discussed so that all the partners could align their tasks for the completion of this project, guaranteeing the quality it aims to achieve.

Dissemination activities, essential for sharing progress and results with the target population, were also analysed. We also planned and scheduled some final dissemination activities.

As part of our cultural agenda, the Union of Parishes of Gondomar, Valbom and Jovim offered Elistat's partners a visit to the Filigree Museum, an ancient goldsmith's art and technique that gives the Municipality of Gondomar the title "Capital of Goldsmithing" in Portugal.

The Transnational Meeting of the ELISTAT Project ended with a ceremony to hand out certificates to the participants, with the consortium confident of having developed a productive working environment and full collaboration.
