WELCOME TO THE THIRD NEWSLETTER OF THE HYPER PROJECT!

The HYPER project is an ERASMUS+ funded project, which aims to empower young people to safeguard themselves from online threats, and to support them in building awareness about the threat of online radicalization. We are now in month 18 of the project and things have progressed really well, especially considering that COVID-19 has made such an impact on everyone's lives in the past number of months.

Update on Intellectual Outputs

Partners have finished the development and production of IO1, which included 12 simulation video resources that show the radicalization process and demonstrates how the most popular digital media channels and programmes are used by those seeking to prey on young people. Along with the 12 videos, partners created self-help resources that address the different circumstances and personality traits highlighted by research in the UK as those which make youngsters more prone to the threat of radicalization. The final materials address topics such as gaming, fake news and recruitment methods. The format of the videos range from cartoons to music videos. Partners are delighted with the final version of these resources and are looking forward to the reaction from project stakeholders.

IO2, the Peer Training Programme, has also been finalized in all partner languages. This resource will support peer youth leaders to take an active role in tackling the radicalization process. It is a very useful, innovative tool that will make a huge bit of difference to people who need it the most.

Partners are in the final stages of creating IO3, the In Service and Induction Training programme. This programme will ensure that front-line youth workers have the capacity to extract the maximum benefit from the new resources developed and that youth volunteers, parents and guardians are properly trained to support them.

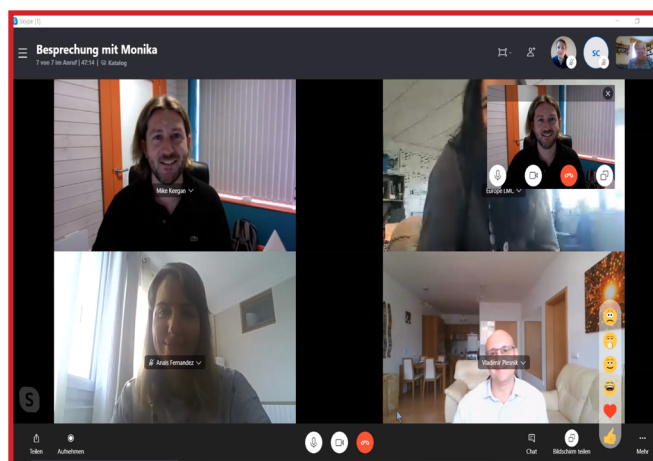
