
MAE Day Across Europe

The 25th of January 2024 is a memorable date for the MAE Project. The organizations in all partner countries dedicated this day to the celebration of all personal stories collected throughout the project in a variety of formats making both meaningful and festive the end of a project to remember.

The Memories Across Europe Day happened simultaneously in Bulgaria, France, Germany, Italy, Poland, and Sweden online and in person. Some events happened either on the same date or the next one. During the whole month of January 2024 – partners presented their final outputs to the wider public, engaging more people in thinking and reflecting on the two major themes “My Europe” and “Stories of Social Change in Europe”.

All events included presentations of the results, ceremonies for awarding the winning stories, reading of the stories and showing video stories, reflecting on the stories, and telling more stories accompanying the events with painting, singing, food, and music.

All participants reaffirmed the importance of (auto)biographical storytelling and the necessity for the older generations of Europe to stay active, share their experiences, and remember the political and social changes they have witnessed or taken part in Europe during the 20th century serving as a reminder for the younger generations in what Europe they want to live in.




