About PLANet B

PLANet B is an engaging and timely youth project that is currently being developed by youth organisations in France, the Netherlands, Cyprus, Portugal and Ireland. In recent years, we have all seen the power and influence of youth-led climate action, and with PLANet B, we aim to tap into the potential of young people who we work with, to address climate change on a local and global level. The project partners aim to support youth workers to develop their skills so that they can introduce climate education in their youth work practice, and so that they can inspire the next generation of climate activists. We all know that there is no Planet B, so we need to take action to protect our planet and our future. Through our European collaboration, we aim to share experiences between countries, to raise awareness of climate action and to foster confidence in young people that their actions can make a difference.



Welcome to PLANet B

Hello and welcome to the PLANet B project. Now that you are here, let's talk a little about what PLANet B is and what we hope to achieve!

How will we achieve this?

These are ambitious aims, we know; so how will we achieve this? Through education of course!

Firstly, we aim to work with youth workers in our networks to provide unique up-skilling programmes that will help them to better understand the climate crisis, and then to create and use innovative education interventions with young people in their groups to raise their awareness about climate issues.

For young people, we will develop a suite of challenge-based learning activities. Specifically, we will develop 30 digital breakouts, which are short online quizzes and puzzles that will help to engage young people in climate education and raise their awareness of climate issues in their own country and in Europe.

To ensure that these education interventions reach our intended audience, all of these education materials will be present through a MOOC – Massive Open Online Courseware. Through this online platform, the education resources will be freely available and accessible to youth workers and young people in Europe and worldwide, so that everyone can take a step towards climate action.
