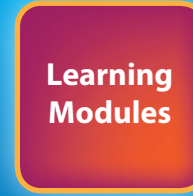

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The project SenApp – Seniors Learning with Apps – aims at developing a training App dedicated for supporting the older generations to use and take advantages of tablet computers to become competent consumers of Internet information, and contributors to the knowledge society. So far the digital divide still concerns the older population to a major extent.

In a mobile learning environment, seniors have access to a well-designed training environment, that:

- Leads the learner into the ICT world through a comprehensive step-by-step approach
- Supports efficiently self-directed learning
- Supports seniors to overcome age related impairments
- Includes a well organised tutoring system
- Includes ways for promoting socialisation in learning
- Integrates a variety of multimedia elements (demonstrations, audio-visual elements, interactive exercises)
- Is offered through a customised mobile learning environment

The project gives a special focus to seniors that fear face-to-face training offers, are mobility restricted or have diverse impairments or disabilities.
