Segeda Sekaisa, the powerfull

Sekaisa (*Segeda* in Spanish) is the name of an ancient <u>Celtiberian</u> settlement, whose remains are located 15 km north of the city of Calatayud city, on a place known as El Poyo de Mara among the municipalities of Mara and Belmonte de Gracián, beside Perejiles River, called Sanamuerta in the old times (as the legeng says its water relieves people).





Segeda Sekaisa, the powerfull

It was a Celtiberian town, whose inhabitants, the Belos and Titos, gave it the name *Sekeida*. In 153 BC it was destroyed in a war with the Roman Empire.

In 1998 excavations began in the area, bringing this ancient settlement into prominence.





Numantia Numancia

Numantia (Numancia in Spanish) is the name of an ancient <u>Celtiberian</u> settlement, whose remains are located 7 km north of the city of <u>Soria</u>, on a hill known as Cerro de la Muela in the municipality of <u>Garray</u>.





Numantia Numancia

The final siege of Numantia began in the year 134 BC. Scipio Aemilianus, who was a Roman consul at that time, was in command of an army of 30,000 soldiers. His troops constructed a number of fortifications surrounding the city as they prepared for a long siege. Resistance was hopeless but the Numantians refused to surrender and famine quickly spread through the city. After eight months most of the inhabitants decided to commit suicide rather than become slaves. Only a few hundred of the inhabitants, exhausted and famished, surrendered to the victorious Roman legions.
