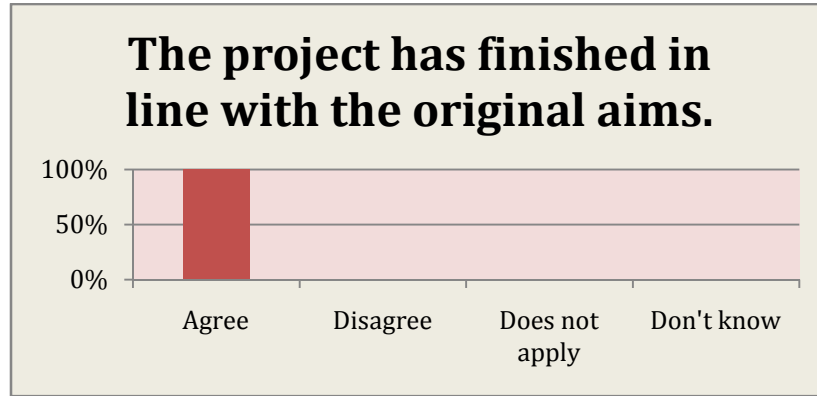


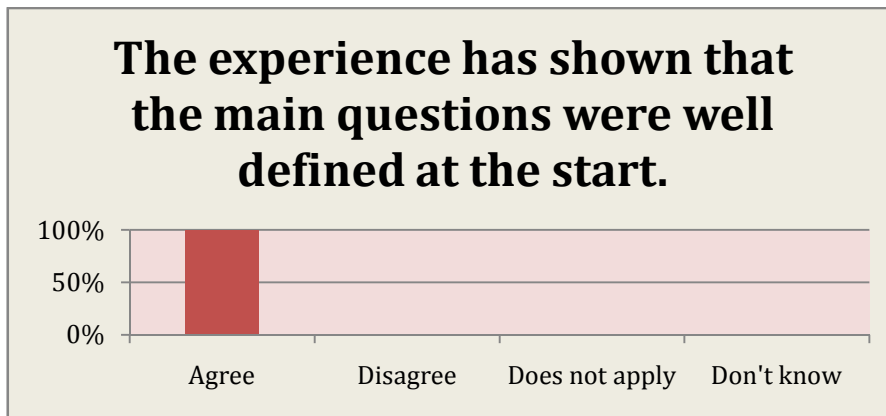
First year Evaluation of IEAT Project

All the partners have the common idea that any changes to the main questions were agreed between the partners in the project.

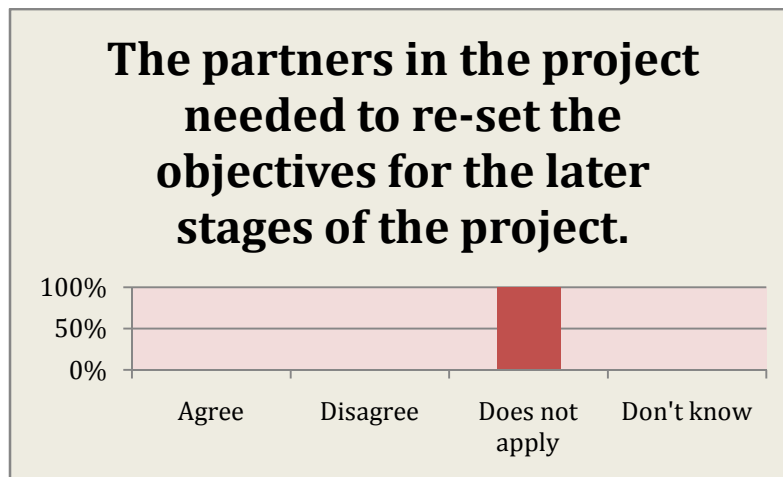
Objectives



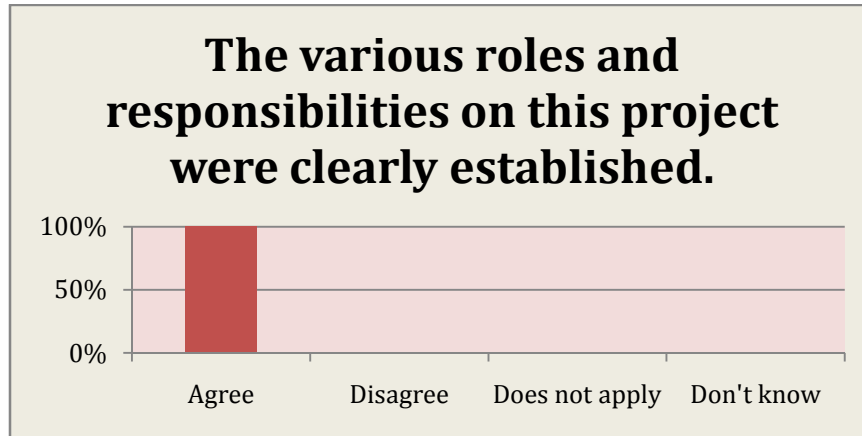
All the partners agree that the project has achieved the objectives.



As it seen from the graphic possible delays were overcome.

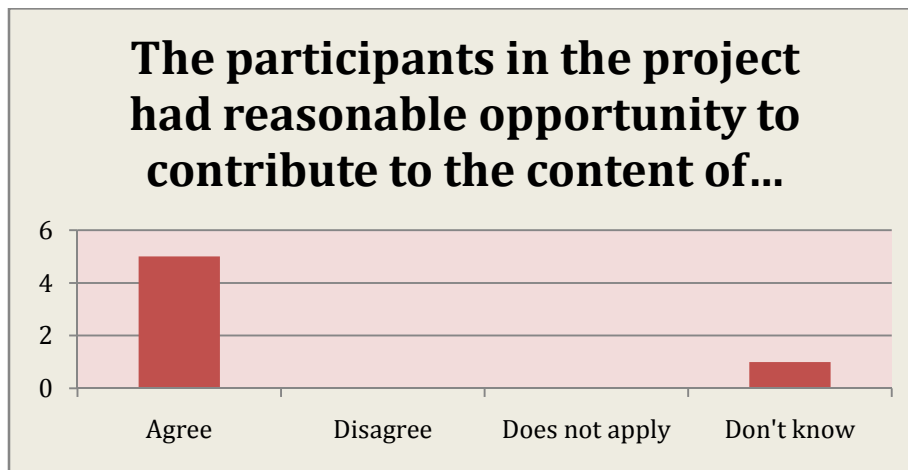


There were no need to re-set the objectives for the later stages of the project.

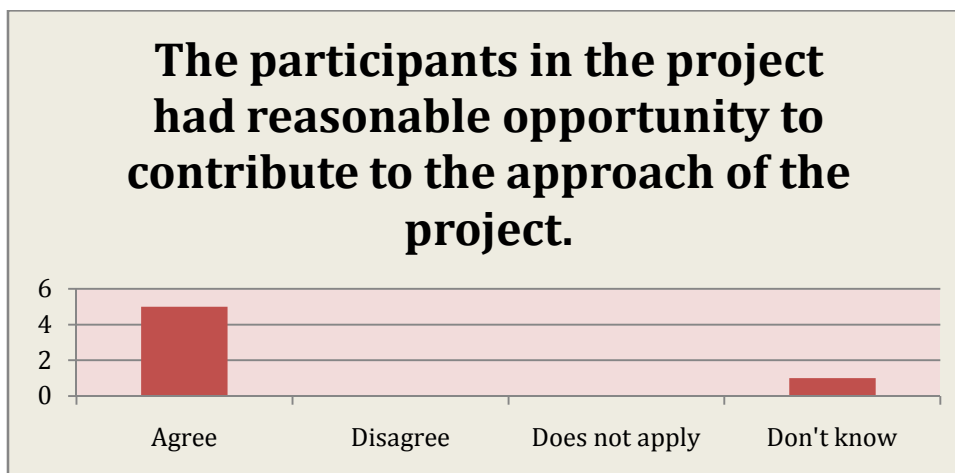


It is seen that all the responsibilities were clearly established.

Involvement

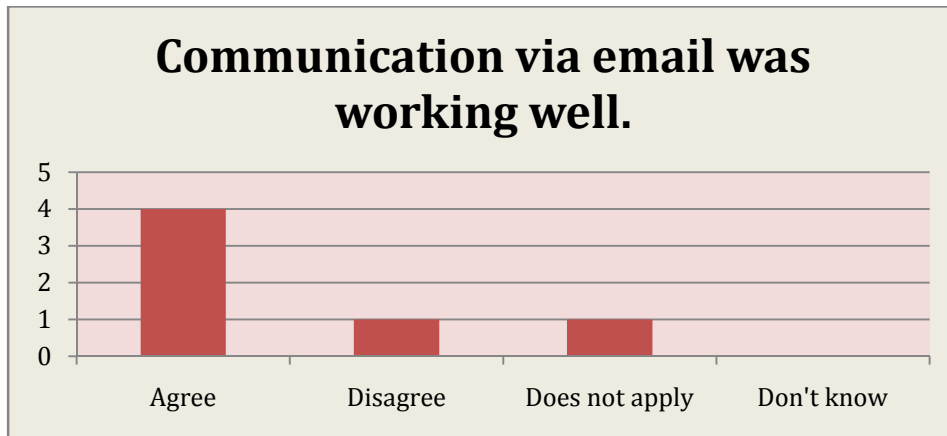


Most of the partners thought that the participants in the project had reasonable opportunity to contribute to the content of the project.

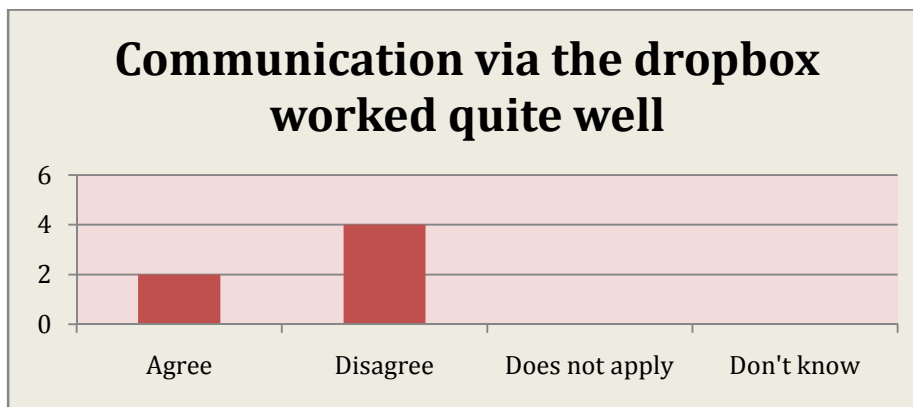


Most of the partners agree that the participants in the project had reasonable opportunity to contribute to the approach of the project.

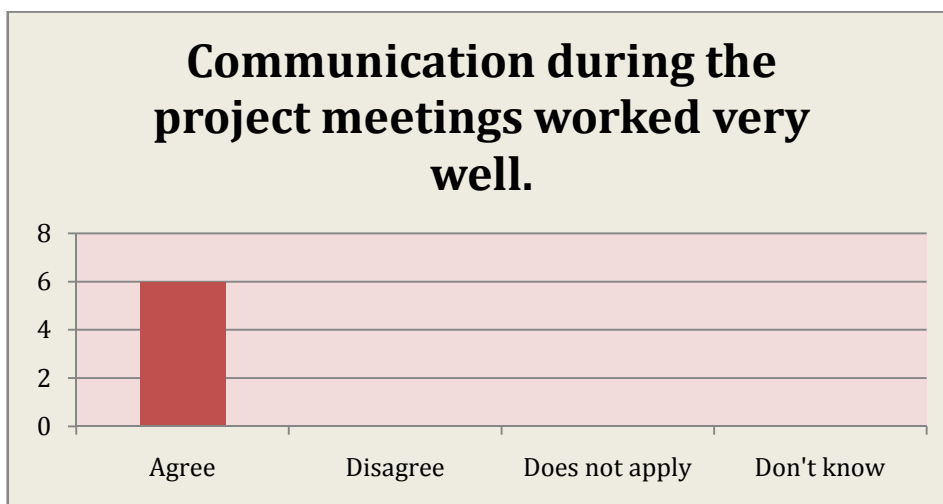
Communication
