

EVALUATION AFTER THE THIRD PARTNERSHIP MEETING IN **SOPIA**

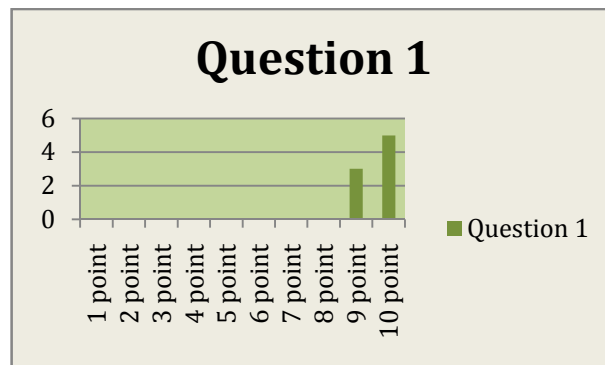
HELD ON **24-25 JANUARY 2014**

According to the given answers and comments;

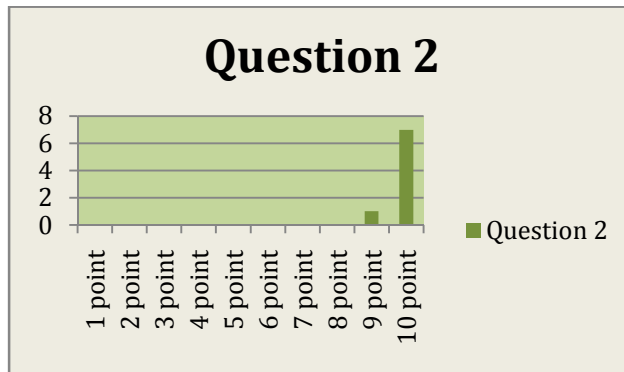
Q1- Were you satisfied with the preparation work for this meeting?

Comments: All the communication before the meeting was quite well.

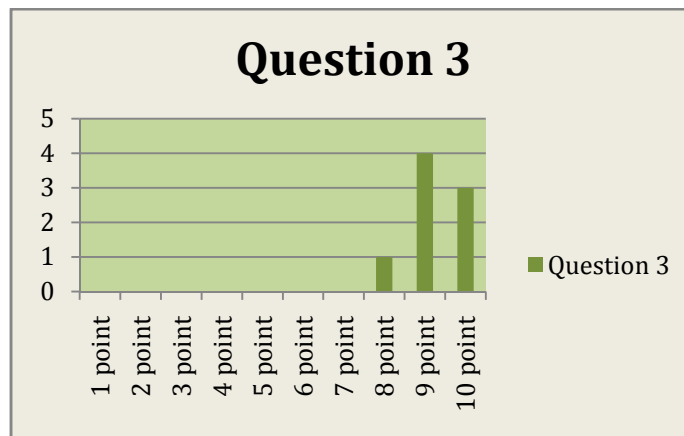
Q2- Were you satisfied with your accommodation?

Comment: Very good price for Hilton Hotel (because of early booking by internet)

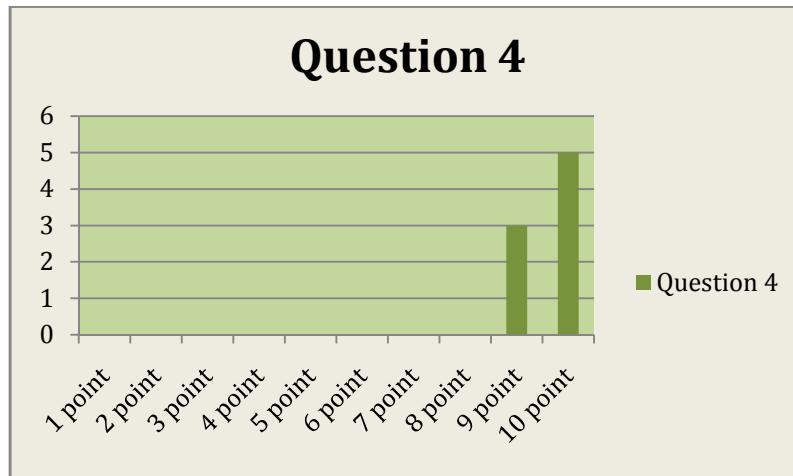
Q3- Were you satisfied with the meeting room?



Three participants gave 10 points, four participants gave 9 points and one participant gave eight point; It means that most of the partners were fully satisfied with meeting room.

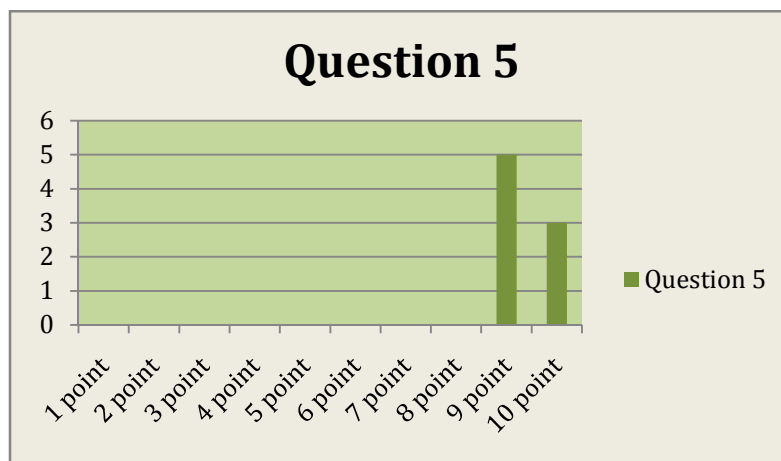
Comment: One partner indicates that Lobby was o.k. for management group; the other meeting room was “open air” at the Surva festival.

Q4- Were you satisfied with presentations of the partners?



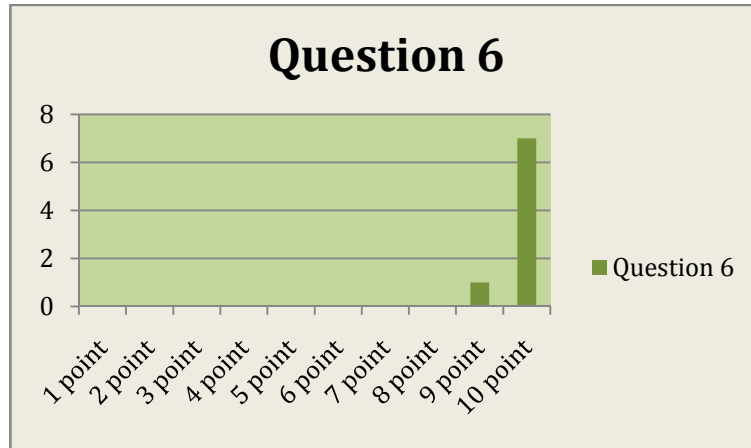
Five participants gave 10 points and three participants gave 9 points; It means that all of the partners were satisfied with the presentation of the partners.

Five participants gave 9 points and Three participants gave ten points; It means that not all the partners thought that internal and administrative issues were discussed properly.

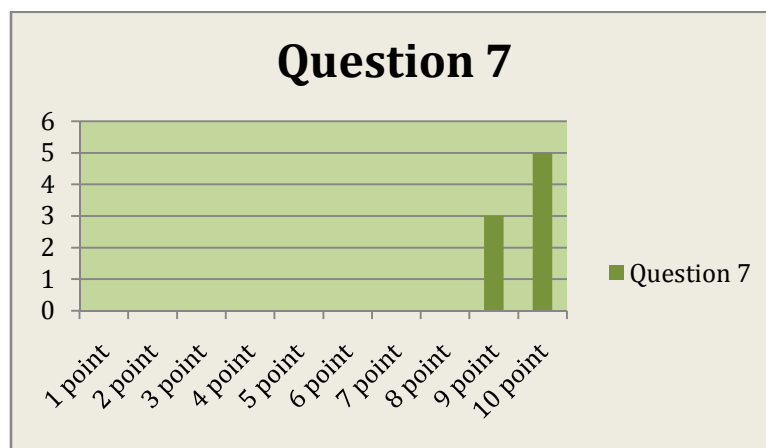
Q6- Do you think the meeting was generally successful? Do you think the members of the project group were able to make some progress and to achieve relevant results?

Comments: One partner indicated that the language class is still missing; we should do just 10 important phrases (daily live) in Adana!

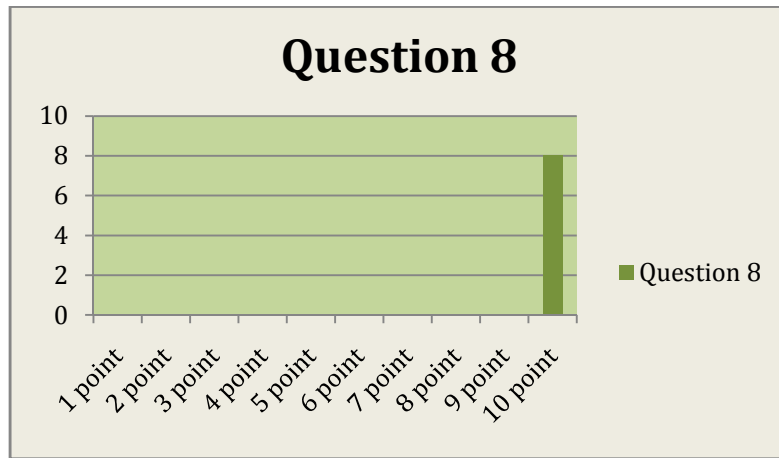
Q7- Were you satisfied with the working atmosphere during the meeting?

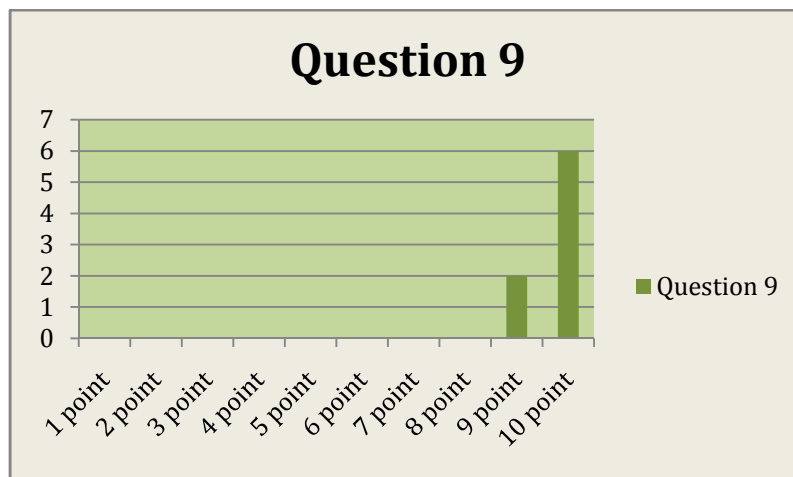
Q8- Were you satisfied with the way the coordinator managed the meeting?

Comments on the event

German partner

Actually the festival was pretty similar to what we call "Karneval", so this was not strange at all besides the fact that the festival itself lasts for at least two days. I liked most of the costumes a lot. It seemed strange to me that the choice of different kinds of food and beverages was very poor at the festival (even if the provided food was good and enough). It was odd for me drinking a glass of pretty cold red wine (even if it was good) since we would prefer drinking mulled wine or hot chocolate at these weather conditions.

Spanish partner

I believe that it has been an experience very interesting and also very different from the type of festivals in my region. I think it is a much more ancient celebration and tribal.

We have seen that this ancient Festival is much more like the festivals that are celebrated in the North of Spain, because they are from Celtic origin and appear more elements such as demons and good and bad spirits.

Instead, festivals in the South of Spain are more colourful, where music and dance make to participate to all the people; organisers and participants. These events usually have a religious origin, such as pilgrimages or come from the old the cattle fairs, where people from all the places they shared several festivals days.

Austrian Partner

a) Strange for me: Costumes (fancy dress) was unusual; music also; all the small restaurant had the same food; Surva is “world cultural heritage” (impressive)!

Our region was hot and plain, that's why the costumes mostly lighter. The atmosphere in this carnival was excellent.
